

Cubing Guide

The cubic measurement of a parcel can be determined as follows:

(measure in meters e.g $\frac{1}{2}$ meter = 0.5)

Length = 85 cm

Width = 15cm

Height = 45cm

- 1) Convert the linear dimensions of the length X width X height to meters
- 2) Multiply the length X width X height x 167 cubic weight

Example

- 1) Length = 0.85m
Width = 0.15m
Height = 0.45m
- 2) (L) 0.85 x (W) 0.15 x (H) 0.45 X
167 = 9.6
- 3) The actual weight of this parcel was found to be 4kg when it was placed on the scales. Using 167kg as the cubic conversion, the cubic weight is 9.6kg.
- 4) Your quote will be calculated on 9.6kg
